THE PREACHING BY PHILIP (Act 8:4-40)

The conversion of the Samaritans and the conversion of the Ethiopian eunuch.

The appearance of the Lord on the road to Damascus; the baptism of Saul by Ananias; the intial ministry and persecution of Saul.

THE MIRACLES OF PETER (Act 9:32-43)

The healing of Aeneas and the raising of Dorcas from the dead.

Departure from Antioch; the ministry on Cyprus; preaching in Pisidia, work and persecution in Iconium, Lystra and Derbe; the confirmation of churches and appointment of elders; the return to Antioch.

30-Jul 8th Sunday after Trinity Acts 14: 8-20: In Lystra.

THE ISSUE OF CIRCUMCISION AND THE LAW (Act 15:1-35)

The problem surfaces in Antioch; the problem is resolved in Jerusalem, the letter is delivered to Antioch.

06-Aug 9th Sunday after Trinity Acts 15: 1-21: The council at Jerusalem.

THE SECOND MISSIONARY JOURNEY OF PAUL (Act 15:36-18:22)

The separation of Paul and Barnabas; The addition of Timothy to Paul and Silas; The call to come to Macedonia; The conversion of Lydia in Philippi; The conversion of the Philippian jailor; The proclamation of Christ in Thessalonica, Berea, and Athens; The year and a half at Corinth; The quick trip back to Antioch.

The strengthening of disciples in Galatia and Phrygia; The conversion of Apollos; The three years at Ephesus, ending with a riot; The trip through Macedonia, three months in Greece and return through Macedonia; The breaking of bread and miracle at Troas; heading toward Jerusalem; The meeting with the Ephesian elders at Miletus; Warnings on the way to Jerusalem; brief stays in Tyre and Caesarea; The arrival in Jerusalem.

24-Sep 16th Sunday after Trinity Acts 18: 18-28: The conversion of Apollos

THE ARREST OF PAUL AND JOURNEY TO ROME (Act 21:18-28:31)

The counsel of James and elders of the church in Jerusalem; The arrest of Paul in the temple; The defense by Paul to the Jewish mob; The defense by Paul before the Sanhedrin council; The plot against Paul and deliverance to Felix; The trial before Felix; procrastination by Felix; The appearance before Festus and appeal to Caesar; The defense before Festus and King Agrippa; The journey to Rome; shipwreck along the way; The explanation of Paul to the leaders of the Jews in Rome; The waiting in Rome for two years, yet preaching and teaching.
